

Red Hat Certified Engineer (RHCE) Preparation Certificate (2496)

This certificate is intended for individuals who have already earned RHCT certification or who possess the skills covered on that certification exam. It prepares students for the highly respected Red Hat Certified Engineer (RHCE) exam. The exam is performance-based, and proves the individual's ability to configure networking services and security on servers running a Red Hat operating system. Since the exam requires candidates to prove those skills covered on the RHCT exam, whether or not the individual holds that certification, the courses also include extensive review of those skills as well.

NOTE: Coursework in this certificate includes a prerequisite that is not included in the certificate. Students with equivalent knowledge and experience may request to have the prerequisite waived. Students who do not have the prerequisite and do not have equivalent knowledge and experience will need to take an additional course.

ITON 2776 has a prerequisite of ITON 1746 Red Hat Red Hat Academy System Administration I, ITON 1756 Red Hat Academy System Administration II, or CNET 2720 Cisco Network Security I: Managing Security; or Red Hat Certified Technician (RHCT) certification or permission of instructor.
