

International Studies Certificate (5101)

The International Studies Certificate provides students with a broad introduction to the historical, political, geographical, economic, religious, and literary bases of the modern world. In addition, students will complete six hours of intermediate language studies. Courses that fulfill the requirements of the certificate transfer to other colleges as general education credits. Certain courses will also transfer to Cleveland State University for the International Relations major in addition to general education credit.
