

Scholarships available for Public Service Students

A variety of state-funded and Lakeland scholarships are available to students pursuing degree and certificate programs in public service areas, including law enforcement, police academy, criminal justice, fire science, emergency medical technology (EMT) paramedics and health technology programs. All scholarships listed provide funds for tuition, fees, textbooks and educational supplies unless otherwise specified.

Lakeland Foundation Scholarships

To apply for any of the scholarships listed below, complete the Lakeland Foundation Scholarship application, which can be found on myLakeland in the "Scholarship Center," located under "myRECORDS."

Andy Nowacki Memorial Scholarship

- For students enrolled in public service programs such as: law enforcement, police academy, criminal justice, fire science, EMT paramedics certificates/programs or a health technology program.

Chief James T. McBride (Commander Emeritus) BPA Endowed Scholarship

- For students enrolled in the basic police academy (BPA) program.
- Recipient must be a Lake County, Ohio resident and have completed at least 15 credits hours of criminal justice coursework.

Donald J. Taverner Memorial Endowed Scholarship

- For students enrolled in the fire science and the EMT/paramedic programs.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.

John D. Grampa Family Endowed Scholarship

- For students who demonstrate they are pursuing a career in law enforcement.
- Students must be a Lake County, Ohio resident.
- Students must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA.

Lake County Government Scholarship

- For students enrolled in a public service major.
- Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA.
- Students must be a U.S. citizen and registered to vote in Lake County, Ohio.

Professor & Lake County Commissioner John F. Platz Good Government Endowed Scholarship

- For students majoring in political science, history or the public services (police, fire or human services).
- Students must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Students must be residents of Lake County, Ohio.

Todd W. Latz Criminal Justice Memorial Endowed Scholarship

- For students enrolled in the law enforcement criminal justice program.
- Students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA.

State of Ohio Funded Programs

Choose Ohio First Scholarship

- For students enrolled in select health care degree and certificate programs.
- Funds are available for tuition, general fees and textbooks.
- Applicant must be new to the eligible program or a new Lakeland student.
- Continuing students new to the eligible program must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Students must be an Ohio resident.
