RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct behind-the-wheel training sessions following Ohio Driver Training Curriculum for teens and adults
- Record student attendance and performance; communicate results to the driving school in a timely manner

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education/Training and Experience Required/Preferred

- High school diploma required
- Valid Ohio driver's education teaching license
- Valid Ohio driver's license for at least three years with no more than three moving violations and no more than three chargeable crashes (or six points) during the last three years
- Submit to criminal history background check; satisfactory criminal history background check as established by the Ohio Revised Code for individuals in positions with responsibility for teaching or supervising children

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of motor vehicle operation and motor vehicle laws for the state of Ohio
- Ability to interface with and instruct teens, role-modeling mature behavior and showing good judgment

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

This is a part-time position with hours scheduled as needed and based on availability. Hours will vary depending on the season, availability of vehicles, etc. Behind-the-wheel sessions are flexible and can be scheduled according to instructors' convenience as long as the hours are reasonable and vehicles are available.

COMPENSATION: \$12 per hour for behind-the-wheel instruction
