

CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grant FINAL REPORT

Acknowledgement

Lakeland Community College has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Total Funds

Lakeland Community College received \$1,536,947 in CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grant Funding for students.

Total Distribution

As of November 17, 2020, Lakeland has awarded \$1,536,947 in CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grant funds to students.

Estimated Student Eligibility

Approximately 4044 students were eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and may be eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

Number of Students Receiving Emergency Financial Aid Grant

As of November 17, 2020, 1244 students have been awarded CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grant funds.

Determination of Distribution

Students enrolled in spring, summer and/or fall 2020 classes who have unforeseen emergency expenses related to the disruption of campus operations (such as food, technology, health care and childcare) due to the coronavirus are eligible to apply for emergency funding. In addition, to receive the funds students must be eligible to participate in the Title IV (Pell Grant and student loan) financial aid programs. Students do not need to be a financial aid recipient but are required to complete either the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
