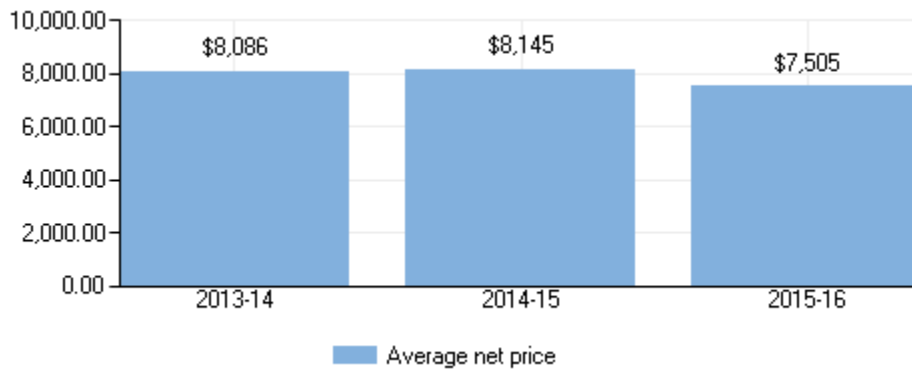

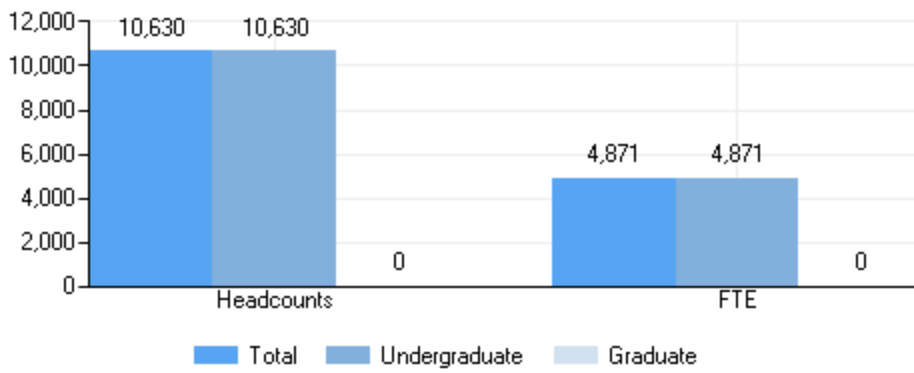

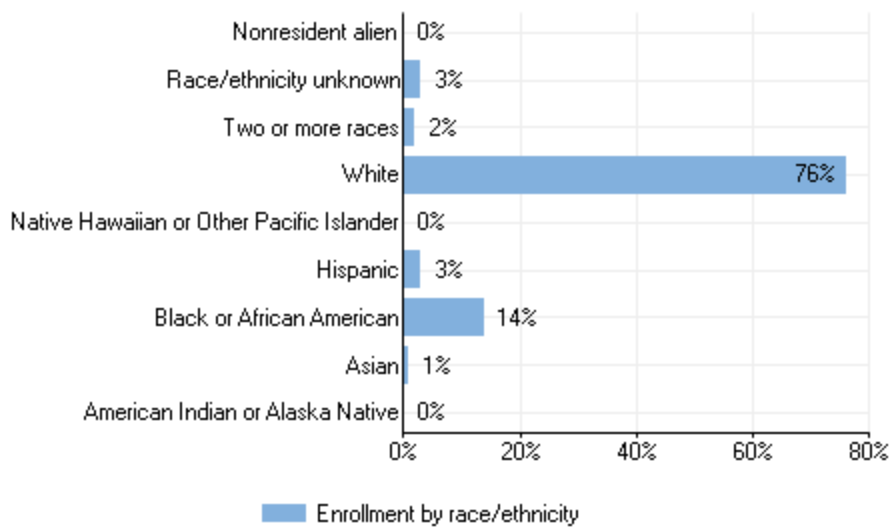
Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2016-17



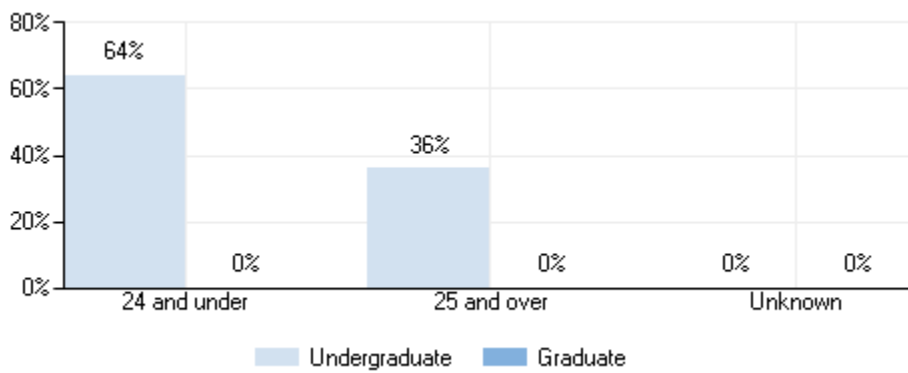

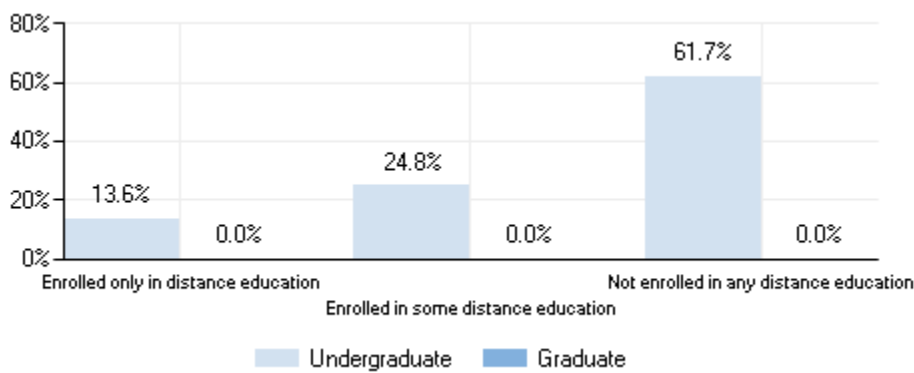
Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2016



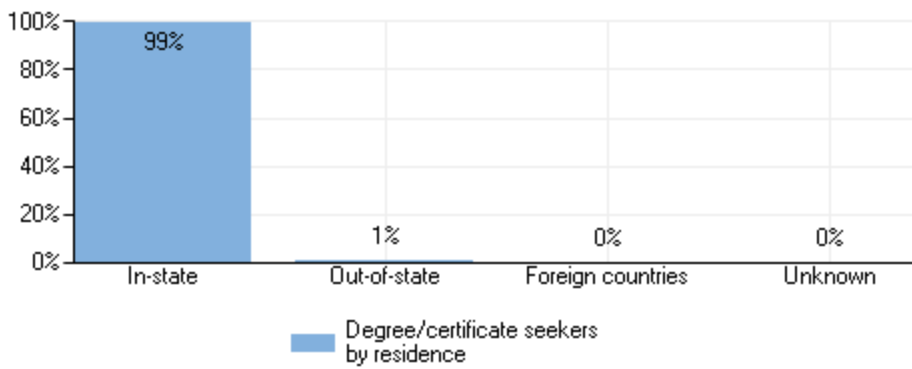
Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2016

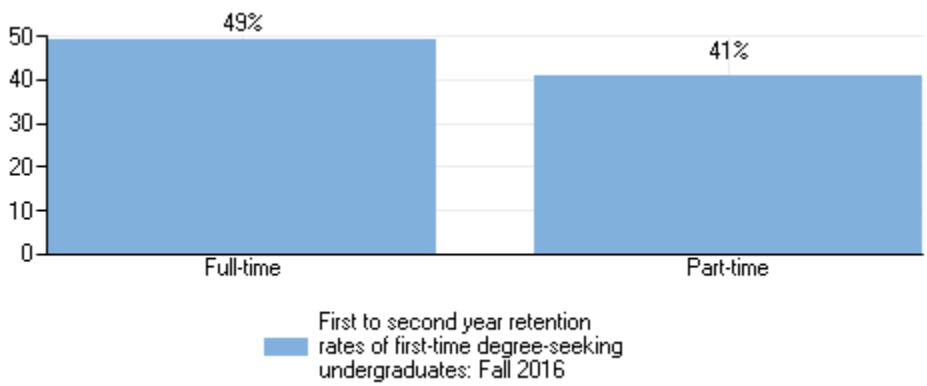

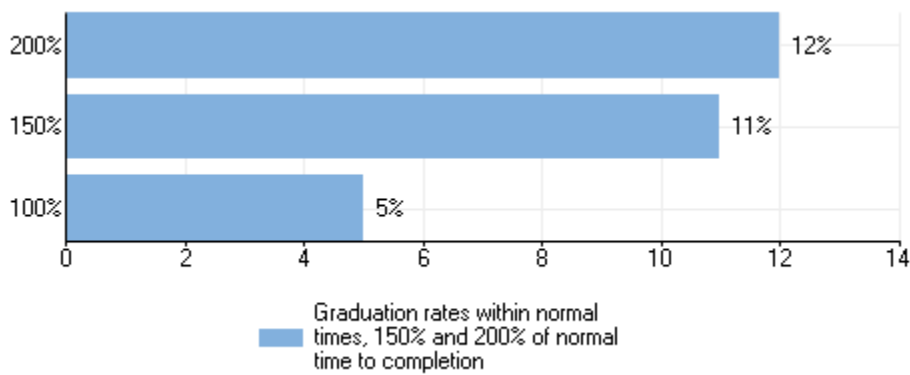

First to second year retention rates of first-time degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2016



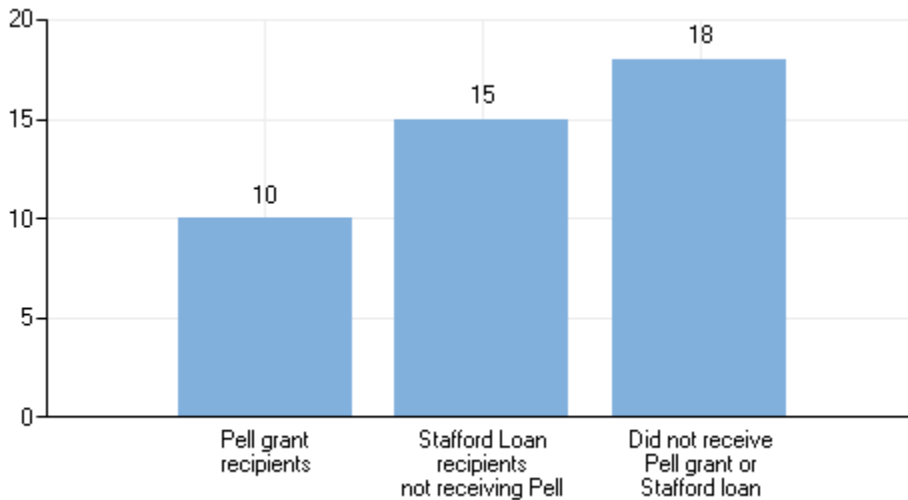
Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within normal time, and 150% and 200% of normal time to completion: 2012 cohort

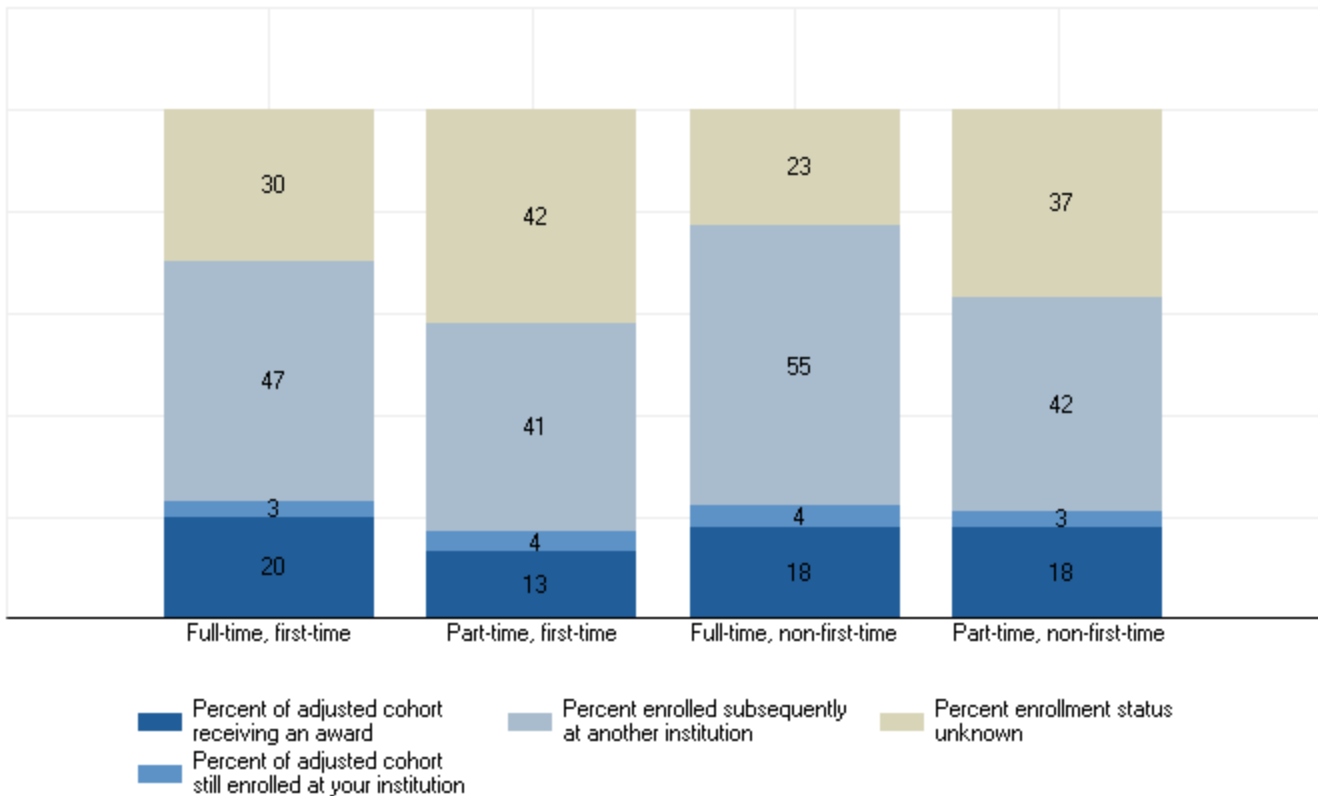
Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by Title IV aid status: 2013 cohort

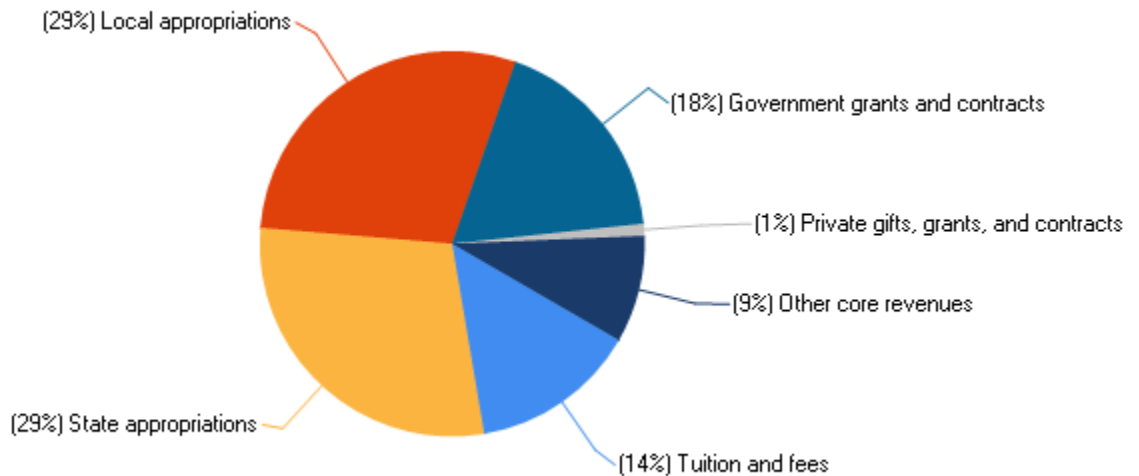
Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2008, by cohort

Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2016

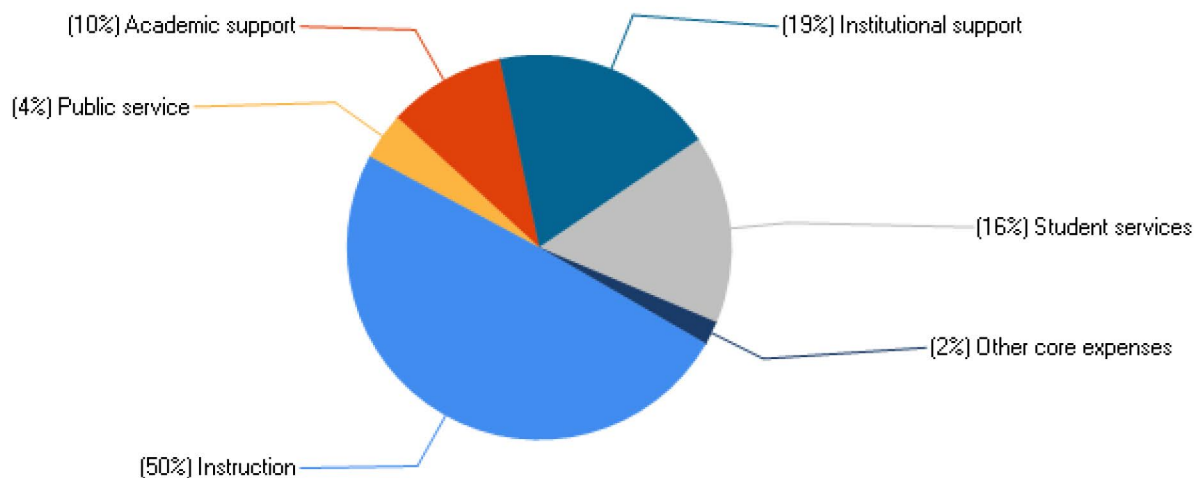


Core revenues per FTE enrollment, by source: Fiscal year 2016
