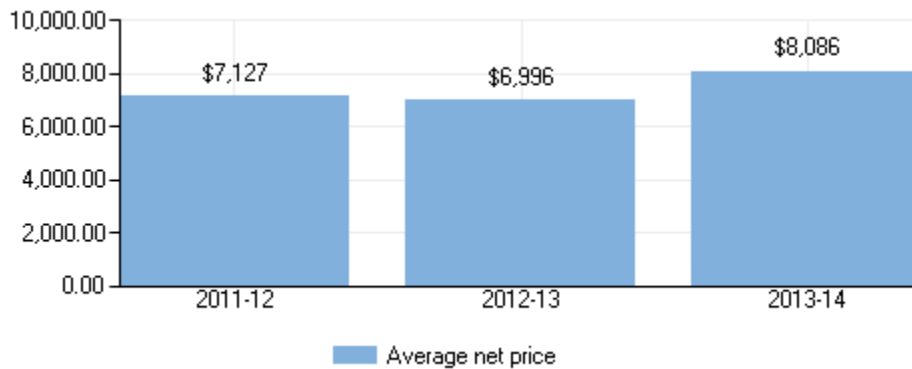

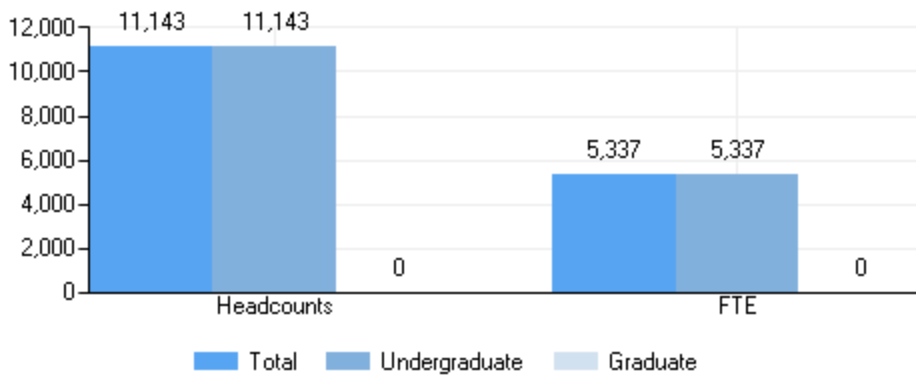

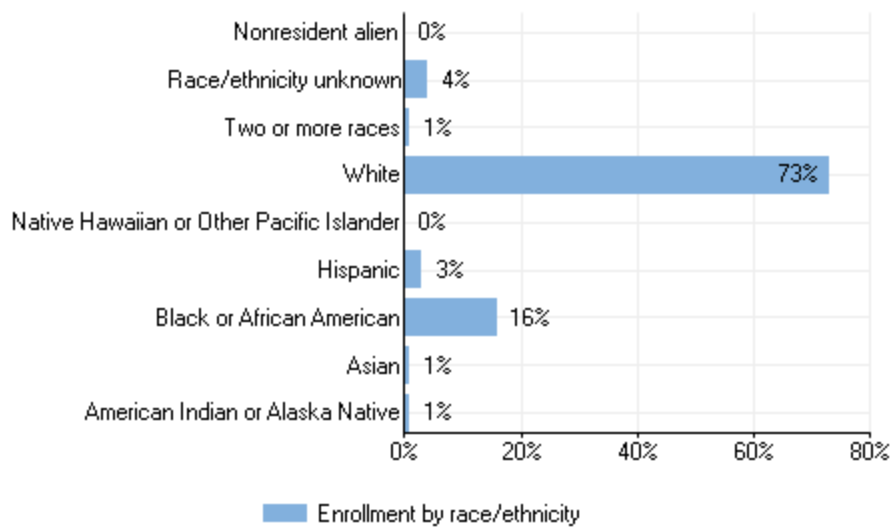
Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2014-15



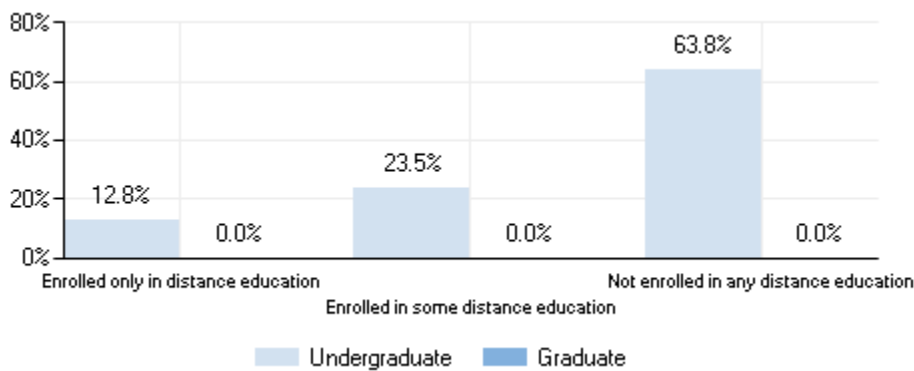

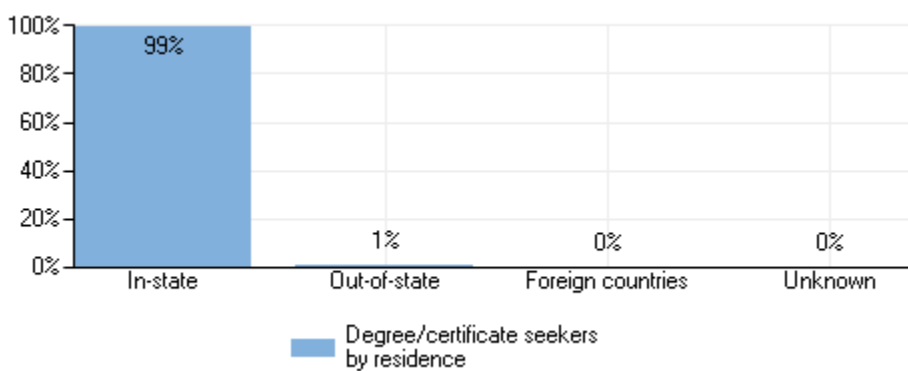
Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2014



Enrollment by distance education: Fall 2014

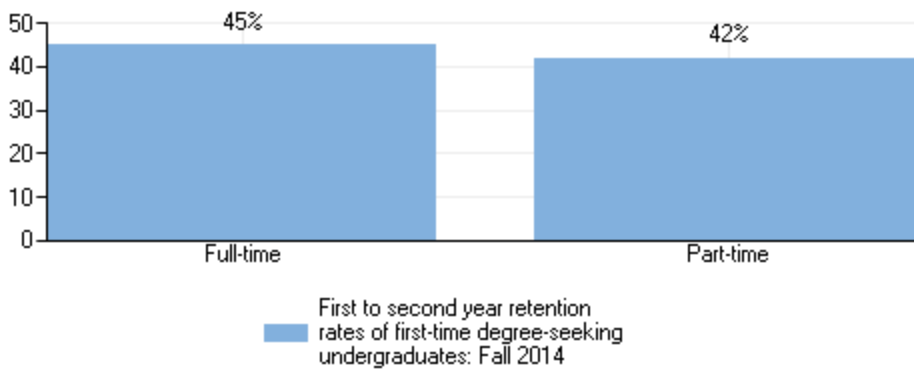


Residence of first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2014

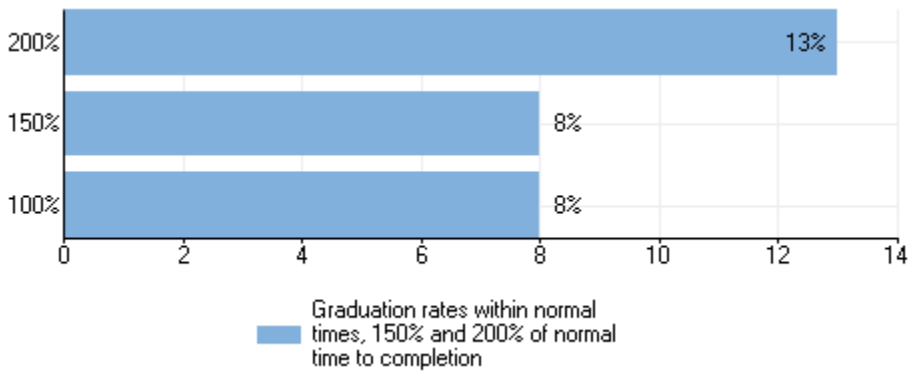
