# A career with no direct patient care.

The health information management field combines business and healthcare and does not require patient care. These professionals typically work Monday-Friday and may have work from home opportunities.

### What you'll learn to do:

- » Medical coding Assign codes to patient charts
- » Medical records and electronic health records Use health technology to assign codes using encoder software
- » Healthcare data analysis Apply knowledge about the revenue cycle that is used in the health industry, by health insurance agencies, and more.

# How long does it take to complete this program and be job-ready?

- » 65 credits (2 years)
- » Program starts fall semester of each year.





## **Credential**

Lakeland's health information graduates are eligible to take the national certification exam to become a Registered Health Information Technician, known as a RHIT.
