<b>Service Project Title</b>	<b>Cradle to Kindergarten – Literacy Program</b>
<b>Date(s)</b>	Application process opens January 2018 – multiyear project
<b>Date and Time</b>	<b>Volunteer schedules are available for Mornings, afternoons and early evening hours.</b>
<b>Full Description</b>	The Cradle to Kindergarten Program is an early literacy initiative available exclusively for new babies born at Lake Health whose families reside in Painesville. The program provides families with free books, materials, and support to empower and engage parents in their child’s literacy development. Books and materials are offered in both English and Spanish.
<b>Important Information</b>	All volunteers will be required to attend two professional development sessions before they are able to complete their first home visit. Volunteers will also be required to complete a background check. There is no cost to the volunteer for background checks.
<b>Location</b>	Home visits can occur in the family’s home or at a neutral location in the community such as a restaurant or coffee shop. The Family Resource Center at Elm Street Elementary School and Morley Library. Typically, home visits will last 30-45 minutes each.
