Community Partnerships


Students are required to complete fieldwork outside the college as well. We look to the community for support in providing quality educational experiences as we prepare students for careers in early childhood education.

We seek centers and programs that provide positive environments for our students as they complete observation hours. Students will spend 2.5 hours observing components of the program that include: teaching methods and strategies, classroom management, positive teacher and student interactions, pedagogical techniques, and maintenance of safe and supportive environments.

Background check and fingerprinting requirement

Pre-service teachers are required to have a current and complete BCI/FBI background check on file with Lakeland's Early Childhood Education office.
