Lakeland Community College has partnered with Lake Health to offer a health clinic on campus.

The clinic is offered to currently enrolled students 18 years of age or older (excluding CCP students) for a nonrefundable flat fee of \$25 per semester*.

Visit lakelandcc.edu/healthservices each semester to opt-in to health services. Opting-in can take place at any time during the semester, but the fee must be paid before using the clinic.

Options for payment include:

- credit card (online)
- cash (in person at the cashier's office located in A-Building, Room A-1032)
- financial aid (for students eligible for financial aid)

The clinic offers:

- Convenient, walk-in appointments
- Services of a Lake Health nurse practitioner

The Lakeland Health Clinic provides basic health care services and treatment for minor illnesses, such as:

- Minor burns, skin rashes or simple lacerations
- Ear infections
- Sore throats
- Strains and sprains
- Minor illnesses
- Minor allergic reactions
- Bronchitis
- Cold and flu symptoms
- Pink eye
- Respiratory infection
- Urinary tract infection
