Lakeland's Information Technology & Computer Science (ITCS) department offers four credit certificates with courses that best meet your needs!

Computer User Certificate (4-7 cr. hr.) prepares students for employment in a variety of positions requiring fundamental computer knowledge and skills. It can be used by non-computer majors to help them with their college work and also might fulfill a requirement in a student's program or degree.

IT Foundations Certificate (7 cr. hr.) prepares students for employment opportunities with fundamental skills in IT&CS.

IT Specialist Certificate (15 cr. hr.) builds upon previous information technology foundation skills and prepares students for employment in a variety of positions requiring more specialized computer knowledge and skills.

IT Professional Certificate (30 cr. hr.) prepares students for employment opportunities in a variety of positions requiring more specialized computer knowledge and skills. It also fulfills one of the designated steps leading to completion for all of the IT&CS degree concentrations.
