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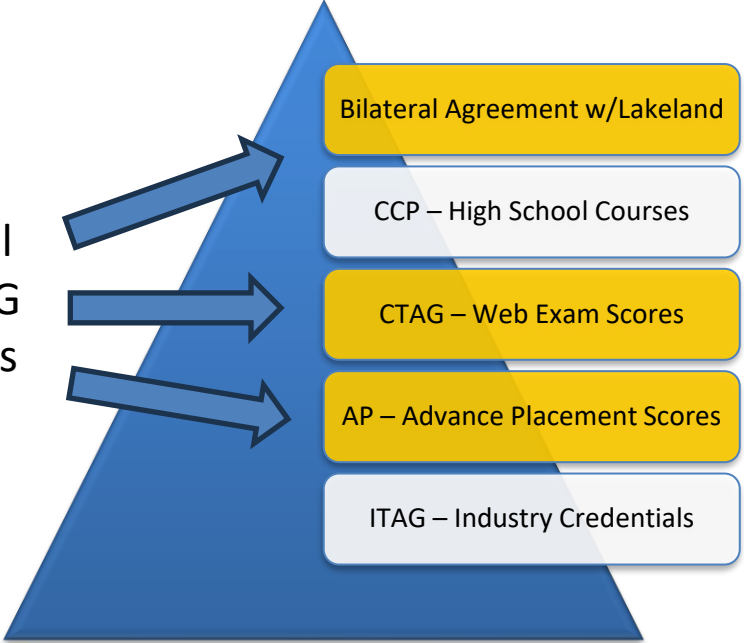

# College Credit Opportunities

In this example, a student earned credit with a bilateral agreement at Lakeland, CTAG credit from Web Exam scores and AP credit.



All types of credit can be stacked but cannot overlap.

# What type of credit can be applied at Lakeland?

## From CTE Course:

### **Career-Technical Assurance Guides (CTAGs)**

CTAGs grant college credit for career-technical coursework taken at either an Ohio public high school or career-technical center. Credit is awarded for a qualifying score on an end-of-course WebXam administered by the Ohio Department of Education.



### **College Credit Plus (CCP)**

CCP is a dual-enrollment program that allows students to earn high school and college credit at the same time. You may apply for CCP admission at any Ohio public college and/or participating private college.



### **Advanced Placement (AP)**

AP exams test students on their mastery of college-level coursework taken in high school. Credit is awarded for scores of 3 or higher on an AP exam administered by the College Board (an independent organization).

# Bilateral Agreement (seniors complete)

- College credit that has been approved by Lakeland for your CTE program completion.

***Important: Bilateral Agreement is made directly between the CTE Program and Lakeland Community College - any accepted credit transfer to another college or university is a bonus!!!***

# Claiming Bilateral Credit (seniors apply)

## 1. Apply to Lakeland.

Students must apply to Lakeland during their high school graduation year, regardless of where they plan to go to college. Applying is easy and only takes a few minutes. CTE students do not have to pay the application fee. After you apply and have your official high school transcript sent, you will receive an email that contains a LID (Lakeland ID), username and password information for myLakeland account. Keep this information for future use!

**Note:** A Bilateral Agreement is an agreement made directly between the CTE program and Lakeland Community College.

## 2. Complete and return the bilateral agreement to your instructor by **JUNE 1, 2025. (set a calendar alarm)**

Your instructor will provide you with a bilateral agreement which needs to be filled out and signed by you and your instructor (page 1 and 2 – two sided). Then, your instructor must submit the signed agreement to the Lakeland CTE office by June 10.

## 3. Send Lakeland Admissions your official high school transcript.

Transcript must come directly from your high school and be sent as an official transcript to **transcripts@lakelandcc.edu**.

### NOTE:

**CTAG** credit is awarded through a system called CTAV and is based on scores earned on the **Web Exam** Assessments.

**ITAG** credit is awarded through a system called ITAV and is based on earning state **approved Industry Recognized Credentials**.

# Why Apply to Lakeland?

- Application fee waived for CTE students.
- Creates a Lakeland transcript to post your college credits.
- Employers may request an official transcript for more pay.
- Other college may request a transcript for transfer students.
- Change your mind about college choice and return to Lakeland.
- Need to complete summer coursework.
- Professional growth coursework assigned by employer.
- Some schools offer CCP credit from Lakeland.



# ODEW / CTE Announcement

On Web Exams, remind students to select the following answer:

*Do you grant permission to Ohio public colleges and universities to post credit associated with the completed WebXam to your transcript if you have applied and intend to enroll at the institution?"*

*Students may answer either:*

*"Yes, I authorize the Ohio public college or university to post credit on my transcript"*

*Or*

*"No, I do not authorize the Ohio public college or university to post credit on my transcript"*

Last year **416/1082 (38%)** students said no, so Lakeland was not able to post credit. Say YES!!!

# ODEW / CTE Announcement

Honors Diploma now lets students substitute "student strength" options for standard requirements.

- » [WorkKeys](#): Score of 6 or higher on all tests (\*void for Career-Tech Honors Diploma)
- » [Armed Services Vocational Battery](#): Score of 50 or above on the ASVAB
- » [Work-Based Learning](#): 250 total hours of work-based learning

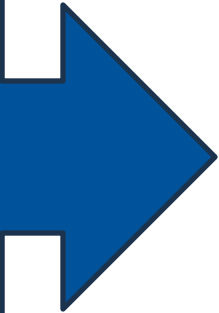

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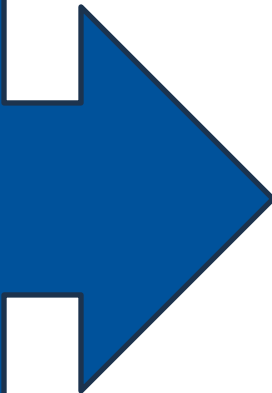

- What should go in a Portfolio?
  - Resume
  - Cover letter
  - Letters of recommendations
  - All certificates, badges, honors, workshops, etc.
  - Copies of Bilateral Agreement, Web Exam certificates, WBL Agreements, transcripts, etc.
- Digital AND hardcopy (could check a lot of OMJ Seal boxes)
- Be your own advocate – keep organized records and ask about your credits.
