The University of Akron RN to BSN Nursing Program offers a career pathway to meet the needs of Registered Nurses who are interested in obtaining a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing. The curriculum is designed for RNs who completed either an Associate or Diploma nursing program as well as RNs with a baccalaureate degree in an area other than nursing. The program is designed for the adult RN learner and learning builds upon prior knowledge and experience. The Baccalaureate nursing program is approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing and is fully accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must have:

- a valid Ohio state license as a registered nurse
- a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 (only the required prerequisite courses are calculated for this GPA)
- all prerequisite and co-requisite courses completed with a grade "C" or higher
