

College Credit Plus Program

Students applying to Lakeland must submit their high school transcript and meet the academic criteria noted below:

- Place into college level English either through successful completion of the Lakeland's placement exam or submission of acceptable ACT/SAT scores.
- **To participate in math courses through CCP, students must have successfully completed Algebra 2 and place into college-level math.

All college credit courses are open to College Credit Plus students, but students must adhere to all course prerequisites and program requirements. A CCP student may only register for remediation free coursework.

Summer Session

High school students will need to follow the four steps for participation including submitting a CCP application and high school transcripts, as well as successful completion of the ACT/SAT or Lakeland's placement exam.

Any courses taken during a summer session will be deducted from the 30 credit hour limit for the academic year immediately following the summer session.

Students planning to participate in the College Credit Plus program and their parents should discuss the important considerations below with their local school district.

1. Program eligibility
2. The process for granting academic credits and the right to share this information with the high school
3. Financial arrangements for tuition, books, materials and fees
4. Criteria for any transportation aid
5. Available support services including student accommodations
6. Scheduling
7. The consequences of failing or not completing a course in which a student enrolls and the effect of the grade attained in the course being included in the student's grade point average, if applicable
8. The academic, social responsibilities and adherence to FERPA guidelines of both students and parents under the program
9. The effect of program participation on the student's ability to complete the district's graduation requirements and possible eligibility to participate in extra curricular activities (band, sports, etc.)
10. Information about and encouragement to use the counseling services of Lakeland Community College
11. The possible financial impact of exceeding the CCP credit allotment



College Credit Plus Program

Lakeland Community College's College Credit Plus program(CCP)

offers students the opportunity to enroll at Lakeland on a part-time or full-time basis, and earn college credit which may also be used to fulfill their high school graduation requirements. The intent of the CCP program is to offer a broad range of college level classes which provide educational opportunities not typically available in high school. Admission into this program is open to students who have clearly demonstrated the ability to handle college-level coursework.



There are two options for participating in CCP:

- **Option A** – Parents pay tuition, books and fees.
- **Option B** – Tuition, books and fees paid by the district or state and the college. Student elects to receive college and high school credit.

*Non-public and home school students **MUST** apply for funding annually. See lakelandcc.edu/ccp for additional information.*

Criteria for participation

Interested students and their parents should follow the **4 steps** below to determine eligibility to participate in the College Credit Plus program.

- Step 1.** File a CCP application online with Lakeland Community College at lakelandcc.edu/apply. Select "College Credit Plus" as your student type.
- Step 2.** Submit high school transcripts.
- Step 3.** Take Lakeland's placement exam and achieve a minimal placement level of ENGL 1110. Students may also submit ACT and/or SAT scores for placement consideration.
** To participate in math courses through CCP, students must have successfully completed Algebra 2 and place into college-level math. Lakeland's placement exam and/or ACT/SAT scores may be used.
Register for the placement exam at lakelandcc.edu/ccp
- Step 4.** Attend a CCP Student Orientation and Registration Session. Parents are required to attend with their student.
