



**Lakeland students may qualify for
Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits!**

Per the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (a federal law), students who were previously excluded from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) may be eligible on a temporary basis if they meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled in at least 6 credit hours (at least half time) for the current semester at Lakeland Community College;
- Have an “Estimated Family Contribution” (EFC) of 0 as determined by the current aid year's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); and/or
- Currently eligible to participate in the Federal Work-Study program (as determined by the Financial Aid Office).
