Lakeland Community College has signed and returned to the Department of Education (ED) the Certification and Agreement and assured that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES), the Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and American Rescue Plan (ARP) to provide emergency grants to students.

Total Funds

Lakeland Community College has received \$8,955,946 in HEERF emergency grant funds for students.

Total Distribution

From January 1 through March 31, 2022, Lakeland awarded \$2,680,684.76 in HEERF grant funds to students.

Number of Students Who Have Received ARP Funds

From January 1 through March 31, 2022, 2,586 students were awarded HEERF grant funds.

Number of Students Who Were Eligible to Receive HEERF Emergency Grant

From January 1 through March 31, 2022, 4,600 students were eligible to apply for HEERF grant funds.

Determination of Distribution

All enrolled students for the 21-22 academic year who have an eligible expenses due to the COVID-19 pandemic including, but not limited to, items related to their cost of attendance, such as tuition and fees, books, food, technology, transportation, medical and mental health care and child care may apply for a maximum of \$1500 in HEERF funding.
