Respiratory therapists are trained to work therapeutically with people who have heart and lung disorders.

Respiratory therapists:

- Initiate and manage life support equipment and artificial airways
- Administer and manage aerosolized medications and gases
- Provide a variety of therapies to people
- Draw and analyze blood samples
- Assist in diagnosing lung and breathing disorders **>>**
- Respond to heart attacks and breathing emergency situations

How long does it take to complete this program and be job-ready?

- » 65 credits (2 years)
- Program starts fall semester of each year.





Credential

Lakeland's respiratory therapy graduates are eligible to take the national certification exam to become a registered respiratory therapist, known as a RRT.
