



Emergency Medical Technology – Paramedic

This paramedic program is delivered entirely in person and does not include any online instruction. Completion meets Ohio's educational standards for paramedic licensure. Because it is not a distance education program, NC-SARA out-of-state authorization does not come into play. In other states, obtaining licensure may require NREMT certification and state-level reciprocity evaluation. If the state is part of the EMS Compact, privilege-to-practice may be possible under certain conditions, but that is distinct from licensure. Prospective out-of-state applicants should consult that state's EMS authority.
